How to Use This Study

Welcome to Anchored in God's Word, a 90-day devotional journey designed to root your faith deeply in Scripture, one morning and evening at a time.

Each day includes a Morning (AM) verse to set your focus as the day begins, and an Evening (PM) verse to help you rest and reflect as the day closes. Alongside each pair of verses you'll find:

- Reflection Questions — to help you personally apply God's Word
- A Prayer — a starting point for your own conversation with God
- An Insight — a short devotional thought to deepen understanding

This study is grouped into eighteen five-day themes, from the Foundations of Faith to Living Anchored, so that your journey builds naturally from one season of growth to the next.

There is no need to rush. Move at whatever pace helps you truly dwell in each day's truth. The goal is not to finish quickly, but to be anchored — steady, rooted, and secure in the One who never changes.

Foundations of Faith

MORNING ☀️ Genesis 1:1

"In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth."

Reflection

What does it mean to you that God is the Creator of everything, including your life story?

EVENING 🌙 Hebrews 11:1

"Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen."

Reflection

Where in your life right now do you need faith for something you cannot yet see?

PRAYER

Father, You spoke the world into being with a word. Remind me today that the same power that created the heavens is at work in my life. Grow my faith to trust what I cannot yet see. In Jesus' name, Amen.

INSIGHT

Faith begins with remembering who God is. Before we ask Him to move mountains, we start each day recalling that He made the mountains in the first place. A faith rooted in His character can rest even in uncertainty.

MY THOUGHTS

DAY 2

Foundations of Faith

MORNING ☀ Psalm 33:6

“By the word of the LORD were the heavens made; and all the host of them by the breath of his mouth.”

Reflection

How has reading or hearing Scripture shaped what you believe about God?

EVENING 🌙 Romans 10:17

“So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.”

Reflection

What practical step could you take this week to spend more time in God's Word?

PRAYER

Lord, let Your Word take root in me today. Speak, and let my faith grow as I listen. Give me hunger for Scripture and ears to truly hear. Amen.

INSIGHT

Faith is not a feeling we manufacture; it is a response to hearing God speak. The more consistently we sit under His Word, the more naturally trust grows, the way a plant grows toward light without straining.

MY THOUGHTS

DAY 3

Foundations of Faith

MORNING ☀ Proverbs 3:5

“Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding.”

Reflection

What decision are you currently leaning on your own understanding for instead of trusting God?

EVENING 🌙 Proverbs 3:6

“In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.”

Reflection

What would it look like to 'acknowledge Him' in that specific situation today?

PRAYER

Father, I confess how often I trust my own reasoning over Your wisdom. Teach me to lean fully on You today, and direct my steps where I cannot see the way. Amen.

INSIGHT

These two verses work together: trust is the posture of the heart, acknowledgment is the practice of daily life. God doesn't ask us to stop thinking, but to stop trusting our thinking above His guidance.

MY THOUGHTS

DAY 4

Foundations of Faith

MORNING ☀ 2 Timothy 3:16

“All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness.”

Reflection

Which of the four purposes of Scripture in 2 Timothy 3:16 do you need most right now: teaching, reproof, correction, or training?

EVENING 🌙 Psalm 119:105

“Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path.”

Reflection

Describe a time God's Word gave you just enough light for the next step, even without showing the whole path.

PRAYER

Lord, thank You for a Word that teaches, corrects, and guides. Let it be a lamp for my feet today, even if I only see one step ahead. Amen.

INSIGHT

A lamp in ancient times didn't illuminate a whole road, just the ground directly underfoot. God's Word rarely shows us the full journey; it gives us enough light to take the next faithful step.

MY THOUGHTS

DAY 5

Foundations of Faith

MORNING ☀ Mark 11:22

“And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God.”

Reflection

What does it mean, practically, to 'have faith in God' this week rather than faith in your circumstances?

EVENING 🌙 Hebrews 11:6

“But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.”

Reflection

How does knowing God rewards those who diligently seek Him change how you pursue Him?

PRAYER

Father, I choose today to place my faith in You above my circumstances. Thank You that You reward those who seek You. Help me seek You diligently. Amen.

INSIGHT

Faith is not aimed at outcomes but at a Person. When Jesus said 'have faith in God,' He pointed His disciples away from the problem in front of them and toward the One who holds every problem in His hands.

MY THOUGHTS

DAY 6

Trusting God's Promises

MORNING ☀️ Jeremiah 29:11

“For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the LORD, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end.”

Reflection

What promise of God do you find hardest to believe applies to your current season?

EVENING 🌙 Numbers 23:19

“God is not a man, that he should lie; neither the son of man, that he should repent: hath he said, and shall he not do it? or hath he spoken, and shall he not make it good?”

Reflection

How does it help you to know that God, unlike people, cannot lie or change His mind?

PRAYER

Lord, thank You that Your plans for me are good, even when I can't see them yet. When my faith wavers, remind me that You always keep Your word. Amen.

INSIGHT

God's promises are not wishful thinking; they are backed by His unchanging character. Because He cannot lie, every promise in Scripture is as good as already fulfilled.

MY THOUGHTS

DAY 7

Trusting God's Promises

MORNING ☀ Joshua 1:9

"Have not I commanded thee? Be strong and of a good courage; be not afraid, neither be thou dismayed: for the LORD thy God is with thee whithersoever thou goest."

Reflection

Where do you need courage today, knowing God goes with you wherever you go?

EVENING 🌙 Psalm 145:13

"The LORD is faithful in all his words, and holy in all his works."

Reflection

What is one way God has proven Himself faithful to you in the past?

PRAYER

Father, give me courage today, not because the situation is easy, but because You are with me. Thank You for Your faithfulness in every season. Amen.

INSIGHT

Courage in Scripture is rarely the absence of fear; it's the decision to move forward because of who is present with us. God's presence, not our confidence, is the foundation for courage.

MY THOUGHTS

DAY 8

Trusting God's Promises

MORNING ☀️ Isaiah 41:10

"Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness."

Reflection

Which phrase in Isaiah 41:10 speaks most to your current need: strengthen, help, or uphold?

EVENING 🌙 2 Corinthians 1:20

"For all the promises of God in him are yea, and in him Amen, unto the glory of God by us."

Reflection

How does seeing every promise of God fulfilled 'in Christ' change how you read the Bible?

PRAYER

Lord, I need Your strength, help, and upholding hand today. Thank You that every promise You've made finds its 'yes' in Jesus. Amen.

INSIGHT

Every promise of God is guaranteed not by our performance but by Christ's finished work. When we read the Old Testament promises, we can read them through the lens of Jesus, who secures them all.

MY THOUGHTS

DAY 9

Trusting God's Promises

MORNING ☀️ Romans 4:21

“And being fully persuaded that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform.”

Reflection

What would change in your prayer life if you were 'fully persuaded' God can do what He promised?

EVENING 🌙 Lamentations 3:22-23

“It is of the LORD's mercies that we are not consumed, because his compassions fail not. They are new every morning: great is thy faithfulness.”

Reflection

How have you experienced God's mercies being 'new every morning' during a hard season?

PRAYER

Father, grow my confidence like Abraham's, fully persuaded that You can do what You've promised. Thank You for mercies that are new again this morning. Amen.

INSIGHT

Abraham's faith wasn't the absence of doubt but a settled conviction over time that God's power matched God's promises. We build that same conviction by remembering His faithfulness morning after morning.

MY THOUGHTS

DAY 10

Trusting God's Promises

MORNING ☀ Psalm 84:11

“For the LORD God is a sun and shield: the LORD will give grace and glory: no good thing will he withhold from them that walk uprightly.”

Reflection

What 'good thing' are you waiting on God for right now, and how does this verse shape your waiting?

EVENING 🌙 Titus 1:2

“In hope of eternal life, which God, that cannot lie, promised before the world began.”

Reflection

How does the promise of eternal life change the way you view today's troubles?

PRAYER

Lord, You are my sun and shield. Thank You for withholding no good thing from me. Anchor my hope today in the eternal life You promised before the world began. Amen.

INSIGHT

God's timing on 'good things' is not the same as withholding them. A shield protects even when we don't see the danger it stops, and the Sun gives warmth even on cloudy days. His care is constant, even when unseen.

MY THOUGHTS

DAY 11

God's Love

MORNING ☀ John 3:16

“For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.”

Reflection

How does knowing Christ died for you 'while you were yet a sinner' change how you view your worth?

EVENING 🌙 Romans 5:8

“But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.”

Reflection

Who in your life needs to hear this same love displayed through you today?

PRAYER

Father, thank You for loving me before I ever loved You. Let the truth of the cross sink deep into my heart today. Help me love others the way You have loved me. Amen.

INSIGHT

God's love was not a reward for good behavior; it was demonstrated at our worst moment. This means our standing with Him has never depended on our performance, but on His finished work.

MY THOUGHTS

DAY 12

God's Love

MORNING ☀ 1 John 4:9

"In this was manifested the love of God toward us, because that God sent his only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through him."

Reflection

How does it change your prayers to know God initiated love toward you first?

EVENING 🌙 1 John 4:10

"Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins."

Reflection

What guilt or shame do you need to lay down in light of Christ's atoning sacrifice?

PRAYER

Lord, You loved me first. Thank You for sending Jesus not because I earned it, but because You are love. Free me from any guilt Christ has already carried for me. Amen.

INSIGHT

Real love always moves first. God did not wait for humanity to get its act together; He sent His Son into the mess. This is the pattern for love we're called to show others too.

MY THOUGHTS

DAY 13

God's Love

MORNING ☀️ Romans 8:39

"Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord."

Reflection

What fear or circumstance has made you feel distant from God's love recently?

EVENING 🌙 Zephaniah 3:17

"The LORD thy God in the midst of thee is mighty; he will save, he will rejoice over thee with joy; he will rest in his love, he will joy over thee with singing."

Reflection

How does it feel to imagine God rejoicing over you with singing?

PRAYER

Father, nothing in all creation can separate me from Your love. Thank You for delighting over me even now. Quiet my anxious heart with Your love today. Amen.

INSIGHT

Zephaniah pictures God not as a distant judge but as a Father singing over His child. Combined with Romans 8, we see a love that is both unshakeable in position and tender in expression.

MY THOUGHTS

DAY 14

God's Love

MORNING ☀ Ephesians 3:19

“And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God.”

Reflection

In what area of your life do you still feel like you have to 'earn' God's love or approval?

EVENING 🌙 1 John 3:1

“Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God.”

Reflection

What does being called a child of God mean for your identity today?

PRAYER

Lord, Your love surpasses my understanding. Help me stop striving to earn what You've already freely given. Remind me today that I am Your child. Amen.

INSIGHT

Paul prays that believers would 'know' a love that surpasses knowledge, a beautiful paradox. Some truths about God's love are meant to be experienced in the heart even when the mind cannot fully grasp them.

MY THOUGHTS

DAY 15

God's Love

MORNING ☀ Psalm 103:11

"For as the heaven is high above the earth, so great is his mercy toward them that fear him."

Reflection

How do you picture the vastness of God's mercy described in Psalm 103:11?

EVENING 🌙 Psalm 136:1

"O give thanks unto the LORD; for he is good: for his mercy endureth for ever."

Reflection

What has God's enduring mercy carried you through recently?

PRAYER

Father, Your mercy is as high as the heavens and as enduring as forever. Thank You for the mercy that has carried me this far. I give You thanks today. Amen.

INSIGHT

Psalm 136 repeats 'his mercy endureth for ever' twenty-six times. The repetition is intentional: some truths need to be said again and again until they settle deep into our hearts.

MY THOUGHTS

DAY 16

Peace in Trials

Date: _____

MORNING ☀ John 14:27

"Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid."

Reflection

What is troubling your heart today that you can hand over to God instead of carrying alone?

EVENING 🌙 Philippians 4:6

"Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God."

Reflection

How does adding thanksgiving to your prayers of request change your perspective on the problem?

PRAYER

Lord, I receive the peace You give, not the fragile peace the world offers. Take my anxious requests today, and I thank You in advance for Your answer. Amen.

INSIGHT

The peace Christ gives is not the absence of trouble but a steady confidence in the middle of it. The world's peace depends on circumstances; His peace depends on His presence.

MY THOUGHTS

DAY 17

Peace in Trials

MORNING ☀️ Philippians 4:7

“And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.”

Reflection

What does it look like practically to keep your mind 'stayed' on God today?

EVENING 🌙 Isaiah 26:3

“Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee.”

Reflection

Where have you experienced peace that didn't make logical sense given your circumstances?

PRAYER

Father, guard my heart and mind with a peace I cannot explain. Keep my thoughts fixed on You today, not on my circumstances. Amen.

INSIGHT

'Perfect peace' in Isaiah comes from a Hebrew phrase meaning peace upon peace, layered and complete. It is available not to those with easy lives, but to those with fixed attention on God.

MY THOUGHTS

DAY 18

Peace in Trials

MORNING ☀ Psalm 46:1

"God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble."

Reflection

What does it mean to you that God is a 'very present' help, not a distant one?

EVENING 🌙 Psalm 46:10

"Be still, and know that I am God: I will be exalted among the heathen, I will be exalted in the earth."

Reflection

What noise or busyness in your life makes it hard to 'be still' before God?

PRAYER

Lord, be my refuge today. Quiet the noise around me so I can be still and know You are God, even in the middle of trouble. Amen.

INSIGHT

Psalm 46 was likely written during a national crisis, yet its center is stillness. Sometimes the most faithful response to chaos is not more effort but a deliberate pause to remember who is still on the throne.

MY THOUGHTS

DAY 19

Peace in Trials

MORNING ☀ Matthew 11:28

"Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest."

Reflection

What burden are you carrying today that Jesus is inviting you to bring to Him?

EVENING 🌙 Matthew 11:29

"Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls."

Reflection

What would it look like to trade your own 'yoke' of striving for His yoke of rest?

PRAYER

Jesus, I come to You weary and burdened. Teach me Your gentle and humble way, and give rest to my soul today. Amen.

INSIGHT

A yoke was designed for two animals to share the load. Jesus doesn't remove all work from our lives, but He invites us to carry it paired with Him, where His strength bears the weight we cannot.

MY THOUGHTS

DAY 20

Peace in Trials

Date: _____

MORNING ☀ John 16:33

“These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.”

Reflection

How does knowing Jesus has 'overcome the world' change how you face today's tribulation?

EVENING 🌙 Colossians 3:15

“And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to the which also ye are called in one body; and be ye thankful.”

Reflection

What would it look like to let peace 'rule' as the deciding factor in a decision you're facing?

PRAYER

Lord, I take courage because You have already overcome the world. Let Your peace rule my heart today, especially in the decisions I'm wrestling with. Amen.

INSIGHT

Jesus doesn't promise a trouble-free life; He promises victory over the world's trouble. Peace, then, isn't the absence of a storm but confidence in the One who has already defeated it.

MY THOUGHTS

DAY 21

Strength & Courage

Date: _____

MORNING ☀️ Philippians 4:13

"I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me."

Reflection

What task in front of you feels impossible in your own strength today?

EVENING 🌙 Isaiah 40:31

"But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint."

Reflection

What does 'waiting on the LORD' look like for you this week rather than pushing forward on your own?

PRAYER

Lord, I cannot do this in my own strength, but I can through Christ who strengthens me. Renew my strength as I wait on You today. Amen.

INSIGHT

Philippians 4:13 was written by Paul about contentment in scarcity and plenty, not about achieving any personal ambition. True strength from Christ is most often shown in endurance, not conquest.

MY THOUGHTS

DAY 22

Strength & Courage

Date: _____

MORNING ☀ Deuteronomy 31:6

“Be strong and of a good courage, fear not, nor be afraid of them: for the LORD thy God, he it is that doth go with thee; he will not fail thee, nor forsake thee.”

Reflection

What fear is holding you back from moving forward in faith today?

EVENING 🌙 Psalm 27:1

“The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? the LORD is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?”

Reflection

How does knowing God will 'not fail thee, nor forsake thee' change your outlook on a difficult relationship or situation?

PRAYER

Father, You go with me and will never leave me. I release my fear today and choose courage, because You are my light and my salvation. Amen.

INSIGHT

Courage in these verses is directly tied to God's presence and promise, not to personal bravado. We can be strong not because we're fearless, but because we're never facing anything alone.

MY THOUGHTS

DAY 23

Strength & Courage

Date: _____

MORNING ☀ 2 Timothy 1:7

“For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.”

Reflection

Which of the three gifts in 2 Timothy 1:7 (power, love, a sound mind) do you need most today?

EVENING 🌙 Psalm 18:2

“The LORD is my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer; my God, my strength, in whom I will trust.”

Reflection

What imagery of God as rock, fortress, and deliverer comforts you most right now?

PRAYER

Lord, thank You that fear is not from You. Fill me instead with power, love, and a sound mind today. Be my rock when I feel unsteady. Amen.

INSIGHT

Fear tries to convince us we are alone and unequipped. But Scripture reminds us that whatever spirit produces timidity is not from God; He equips His children with power, love, and clear thinking instead.

MY THOUGHTS

DAY 24

Strength & Courage

Date: _____

MORNING ☀ Ephesians 6:10

“Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might.”

Reflection

In what specific way do you need to be strengthened 'in the Lord' rather than in your own resolve today?

EVENING 🌙 1 Corinthians 16:13

“Watch ye, stand fast in the faith, quit you like men, be strong.”

Reflection

What does 'standing fast' in your faith look like when circumstances pressure you to compromise?

PRAYER

Father, strengthen me not in my own resolve but in the power of Your might. Help me stand firm today, watchful and unwavering in faith. Amen.

INSIGHT

Being 'strong in the Lord' is different from being strong-willed. One draws from an endless source; the other runs out. Ephesians 6 goes on to describe spiritual armor, because this strength is for spiritual battles, not just physical ones.

MY THOUGHTS

DAY 25

Strength & Courage

Date: _____

MORNING ☀ Psalm 31:24

"Be of good courage, and he shall strengthen your heart, all ye that hope in the LORD."

Reflection

What connection do you see between hoping in the Lord and having courage?

EVENING 🌙 Psalm 28:7

"The LORD is my strength and my shield; my heart trusted in him, and I am helped: therefore my heart greatly rejoiceth; and with my song will I praise him."

Reflection

When has trust in God led you to a place of rejoicing, even before the outcome changed?

PRAYER

Lord, strengthen my heart today as I place my hope in You. Thank You for being my shield and my help. I will sing praise to You even now. Amen.

INSIGHT

Notice the order in Psalm 28:7: trust comes first, then help is felt, then rejoicing follows. Often our emotions catch up to our faith only after we've chosen to trust, not before.

MY THOUGHTS

DAY 26

Wisdom

Date: _____

MORNING ☀ James 1:5

“If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him.”

Reflection

What decision do you need to bring to God in prayer, asking specifically for wisdom?

EVENING 🌙 Proverbs 1:7

“The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge: but fools despise wisdom and instruction.”

Reflection

What does 'the fear of the LORD' practically look like in your daily choices?

PRAYER

Father, I lack wisdom for the decisions ahead of me. Thank You that You give generously without finding fault. Grant me wisdom today. Amen.

INSIGHT

James assures us God gives wisdom 'liberally,' without scolding us for needing to ask again. We can come to Him repeatedly for guidance without fear of exhausting His patience.

MY THOUGHTS

DAY 27

Wisdom

Date: _____

MORNING ☀ Proverbs 2:6

“For the LORD giveth wisdom: out of his mouth cometh knowledge and understanding.”

Reflection

Where have you been seeking wisdom from sources other than God lately?

EVENING 🌙 Proverbs 9:10

“The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom: and the knowledge of the holy is understanding.”

Reflection

How would viewing God with holy reverence change the way you approach a current problem?

PRAYER

Lord, all true wisdom comes from You. Teach me to seek understanding first from Your mouth, and to hold You in reverence in every decision I make. Amen.

INSIGHT

Wisdom in Proverbs is never abstract intelligence; it's skill for living rightly, rooted in relationship with God. Knowledge without reverence for Him can become knowledge misused.

MY THOUGHTS

DAY 28

Wisdom

Date: _____

MORNING ☀ Colossians 3:16

“Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.”

Reflection

How richly would you say Christ's word is 'dwelling' in you right now?

EVENING 🌙 Ecclesiastes 7:12

“For wisdom is a defence, and money is a defence: but the excellence of knowledge is, that wisdom giveth life.”

Reflection

In what way has godly wisdom protected you from a harmful choice in the past?

PRAYER

Lord, let Your Word dwell richly in me today. Teach me wisdom that gives life, not just knowledge that gives information. Amen.

INSIGHT

Ecclesiastes compares wisdom to money as a 'defence,' but notes wisdom's advantage: it doesn't just protect, it gives life. Worldly resources can shield us; godly wisdom transforms us.

MY THOUGHTS

DAY 29

Wisdom

Date: _____

MORNING ☀ Proverbs 16:9

"A man's heart deviseth his way: but the LORD directeth his steps."

Reflection

What plans have you made recently that you need to hold loosely, trusting God to redirect if needed?

EVENING 🌙 Psalm 32:8

"I will instruct thee and teach thee in the way which thou shalt go: I will guide thee with mine eye."

Reflection

How have you experienced God's guidance, even subtly, in the past?
